#### DESCRIPTION

- "LCPD Auxiliary Police Texture Modification"<sup>†</sup>: The following modification replaces the textures of the default LCPD patrol cars (Police1 and Police2) with a custom made LCPD Auxiliary texture inspired by the old NYPD Auxiliary Police paint scheme.

#### REQUIRED PROGRAMS

- *OpenIV* (by GooD-NTS) OR *SparkIV* (by Aru)
- *Microsoft Notepad* OR *Wordpad*

#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Before proceeding, locate and BACKUP your "vehicles.img" file located in your "...\Grand Theft Auto IV\pc\models\cdimages" directory.
- Use OpenIV or SparkIV to replace the "police\_livery" texture file within "police2.wtd" inside "vehicles.img" with the "police\_livery.png" image file we have provided.
- Use OpenIV or SparkIV to replace the "vehicle\_generic\_police\_livery" texture file within "vehshare.wtd" inside "vehicles.img" with the "vehicle\_generic\_police\_livery.png" image file we have provided. (Make sure to set the "Levels" to 1 when replacing a texture in OpenIV.)
- Use Notepad or Wordpad to open "carcols.dat" located in your "...\Grand Theft Auto IV\common\data" folder. (Remember to create a backup.)
- Locate the line "police, 113,74,113," and replace it with:  
"police, 0,113,0," (without the " ").
- Locate the line "police2, 113,74,113," and replace it with:  
"police2, 0,113,0," (without the " ").
